

International Baccalaureate

The University of Redlands International Baccalaureate credit policy allows credit for higher-level course scores. Scores of 5 or 6 may earn 4 credits and scores of seven may earn 8 credits. Specific International Baccalaureate higher level credit policy is established by individual academic departments.
