



- I found that when I was considering coming to the school and the decision was still on the table, people were very tentative and helpful with any questions I had however the second I signed on the dotted line and committed to coming into the program, whenever I had a question to the same individual I was pawned off and advised to contact someone else. It just made me feel like their job was done in obtaining my commitment so they no longer had use for me, and in the beginning of the program it had made me kind of mad. I ended up reaching out to my student services manager through moodle and whatever links they have to reach them, which was great because they were awesome in responding timely however it was agitating being pawned off when my questions weren't that difficult. Moral of the story, this person shouldn't have said they were here for any questions or issues I had because it was only conditional.






















